



WHAT TO EXPECT FROM YOUR ROOFING PROJECT



- First: You should expect to get a great roof from a licensed, bonded and insured company with great references. A company that cares about each and every job as if it were their own house. A worry free roof installed by clean, professional, hard working individuals that have one goal in mind; installing a great roof for you and your family.

- Re-roofing is not a very intrusive project, however dust, debris and noise are commonplace. You **will not** have workers intruding through your living areas, however, re-roofing can be a fairly loud process. Inevitably you will hear what's happening on the roof when workers are removing several tons of material and pulling thousands of nails with the use of shovels and various hand tools. We strive to complete this process as quickly as possible to limit the impact on your daily life.

Questions or concerns? Please Do not hesitate to ask...

- It is possible that small amounts of debris may fall into the attic space or in through open garage ceilings, possibly even through the cracks of tongue and groove ceilings. In some instances it may be recommended the occupants cover anything stored in the attic which may be of importance.

- Satellite dishes are the responsibility of the company that owns them. They are usually prompt in coming out to reattach if for some reason we cannot get them placed back correctly. Typically we wait until installation day to remove/install roofing under these satellites. We try our best to replace them to their original position, however, we are roofers first. Any weathervane or other non-typical rooftop device will be placed back in their original positions but not absolutely guaranteed to be up to original specifications.

- Any pets should be kept away from the perimeter of the house while the work is being completed. Furthermore, any occupants, defined as; any man, woman or child should maintain a 10' barrier from all rooflines while work is being performed. This will help to ensure safety from falling debris. Please maintain a safe distance from any work vehicle, ladders and never walk between the dump truck and residence. The closer we can get to the residence the better. Please keep the driveway clear.

- Please walk with caution until we clean up the perimeter and surrounding areas after removal and have had the opportunity to scour the grounds with our magnets for any loose nails.
